sensitization phase			
7mins	Greeting and introduction	show pictures of me , and my country of origin our food, culture and what we are made off. Question: Do you know where the principal export of gold and sown wood, petroleum? Where in the world is located? Or where do you think most of the world's cocoa comes from? In/from which country? The pupils simply try to guess, and I give the answer to the question: in / from Ghana. I briefly introduce the outline.	The students get to know me, my country (Ghana) and the WUS.
20 Min	Next slide	The term sustainability is explained and the 17 SDG goals relating to Tree (Palm Tree) are explained the students would first say (via brainstorming/ voluntarily depending on the student's previous knowledge in the class) to the question of whether they already have any ideas about the abbreviation "SDGs" (5mins). Then I tell them what the SDGs is about.	Students learn a general overview of sustainability and understand why we have these 17 goals, i.e. the importance of the SDGs
20mins	Next slides will be Overview of the main topic	Introduce the concept of tree or plant (palm tree) and its role in sustainable development. As a transition, the pupils will watch a video or pictures of palm plants. Ask questions about this: Why do you want to work later? What would you do if you later earned very less than you were allowed	Pupils are given an overview of the term in a few questions relating to the topic. The aim is to uncover their previous knowledge. They are also given information about the origin of the palm tree or plant-

		to earn at work for the unused food?	
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10 mins	Next Slides	in a video showing the palm plant, its food and drink like palm wine, chair etc. and how is mined. The aim is to show various importance of palm trees, and its benefits compared with similar tree e.g. Teak or mahogany. Possible question beforehand: in your opinion, how could you also have embraced in your country?	Pupils are given an overview of the various benefits of the Palm tree or plant.
Options for action			
10-20 Min.	The next Slides talks about How much do you know about trees when it comes to the SDGs?	Summary of the topic with a quiz, brainstorming (5 min). Before that I will show a video and pictures of what we get from palm trees, especially in the wood sector. Reflection through some questions and their discussion in groups. Question: Do you think we could achieve the SDGs by 2030?	Check that the students have understood the main points of the topic and consolidate their knowledge. General comments or questions from the students amid the workshop are expressed.
