


MARRIED IN CULTURAL TRADITION TRADITION SLAVERY

98% of people trafficked for sexual exploitation are women and girls. Bride trafficking is common in the interior villages of Haryana, India. Trafficked brides are locally known as Paro or Molki. All the activities of Paro are dependent on the inclinations and circumstances of their buyer.

2.2 million people in slavery are exploited by governments. Nearly one in 20 North Koreans are estimated to be in modern slavery. Citizens are subjected to state-imposed forced labour within the country, where the government requires forced, uncompensated labour from workers, school children, and students.
